
Each year I work on a different project. If 2015 was for low-key nude and 2016 for body in motion, 2017 will be totally different and surprising.


























MARIANO MARCETTI



I feel I have taken quite a fast track in my journey but now I find myself ready to explore job opportunities in this field.




























GIUSEPPE PISANA



I'm always looking for an impact factor and the compositions good to impress no matter who will be seeing the picture. Photography in me is continuously growing and evolving, both artistically and technically.












































SANDRO ALIANO

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

















